

Agreement to waive the right to a Special Partner's Pension as laid down in the Pension Regulations and Article 57 of the Pension Act.

The parties hereby agree that the former partner waives the right to the Special Partner's Pension, which was obtained on the basis of the applicable pension regulations on the date on which the society (common household) was terminated.

The parties declare that:

- society has ended per d.d. ... /..... /.....;
- the Special Partner's Pension will not be allocated to the former partner in accordance with the pension regulations and the Pension Act.

By signing this agreement, the former partner loses the right to the Special Partner's Pension vis-à-vis the pension provider. This means that in the event of the death of the (former) participant, the former partner is not entitled to a benefit.

The request for waiver of the Special Partner's Pension shall only have effect if:

- this agreement has been fully completed and signed by both parties and has been received by Zwitserleven no later than 6 weeks after the date of the cover letter;
- the copy of the identity documents of both parties is attached; and
- Zwitserleven has expressed its willingness to agree to this request.

Explanation

In this explanation you can read what the Special Partner's Pension is. It also explains what relinquishment of the Special Partner entails.

Partner's pension

You and your partner have broken up. Your former partner remains entitled to the Partner's Pension. It concerns the part that has been built up until the date of termination of the partner relationship. This pension is called the Special Partner's Pension.

Special partner's pension

The Special Partner's Pension is intended for the former partner. This will result in payment upon your death. Because there is not always a need for the Special Partner's Pension, the former partner can waive it.

Special partner's pension waiver

Renunciation of Special Partner's Pension can be arranged with a cohabitation agreement or an agreement of termination. This can be done at the notary. You can also waive by completing and signing this agreement.

Consequences of the distance between special partner's pension

As soon as your former partner waives his/her entitlement to a Special Partner's Pension, he/she loses the right to a benefit upon your death. The Special Partner's Pension is then used as a Partner's Pension for a possible new partner.

Copy of proof of identity

Because the consequences of renouncing Special Partner's Pension can be significant, we would like to receive a copy of the identity documents of both partners.
